INTRODUCTION

Utkal University, established in the year 1943, is the seventeenth oldest University in India. Its campus at Vani Vihar is located on a sprawling 399.99 acre area in the heart of Bhubaneswar on the National Highway No-5 connecting Kolkata & Chennai. The foundation stone of the campus was laid by Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India on 1st January 1958 and the campus was inaugurated by Dr. S.Radhakrishnan, the second President of India on 2nd January 1963. A teaching-facilitating University, Utkal University, at present, has 27 Post Graduate Departments in its campus for studies and research in the disciplines of Science, Humanities, Business Administration, Commerce, Law & Commerce. Utkal University is the largest affiliating University in the Country with 38 affiliated general colleges including 13 Autonomous Colleges, 73 Professional Colleges, 5 Medical Colleges, 4 Medical Colleges and 2 Constituent Law Colleges.

University Law College is a constituent college of Utkal University and started functioning on the Utkal University campus from the academic session 1975-1976 as an evening teaching department. The college achieved a glorious record in a very short span of time and became a most sought and popular institution by the students desirous of pursuing career in legal education. Shifted into its new premises at Vani Vihar square off N.H.5 within the Utkal University campus in the year 1996. Now the college is functioning in morning and day shift and imparting 3yr. L.L.B, 5yr. integrated Law and Human Rights from 2012-13. The college is well connected with road and train services with all facilities of the country.

OBJECTIVES:-

- To be a center of excellence in the field of legal education by adopting modern teaching and training techniques.
- To impart high quality legal education and to develop overall personality of the student in a disciplined environment.
- To make its Law graduates/ Post-graduates capable of pursuing a career at Bar, competing for Judicial services, civil services, Defense services and placements in Multi-national corporations.
- To imbibe high sense of social and moral values among students.
- To develop and promote national integration.

3. DURATION :-

The duration of the Course leading to the award of MASTER OF LAW IN HUMAN RIGHTS Degree of Utkal University shall spread over for a period of two academic years.

A candidate for MASTER OF LAW IN HUMAN RIGHTS Degree shall be required to appear in the examination in Four Semesters.

A candidate has to appear respective Semester Examinations every year.

Every student admitted to the Course shall be required to attend at least 75% of class during each Semester.

4. ELIGIBILITY :-

A second class Bachelors degree in Law equivalent to the Degree of Utkal University is eligible for admission to the Course.

From among the eligible candidates selection for admission to the Course shall be made on the basis of the procedure to be decided by the Departmental Teaching Council/Post Graduate Council.

No student shall be ordinarily admitted as a matter of right or provisionally to the 1st Semester Class of the Course unless he full fills the criteria for admission. Admission to subsequent Semester is subject to fulfillment of Rules and Regulations set by the P.G.Council & the college from time to time.

Admission to the next Semester Class shall be completed within six weeks after publication of the qualifying examination results of Utkal University.

Provided further that if a student could not appear in the University Examination at the end of any Semester due to shortage of attendance, shall be allowed to take admission in the same class at the beginning of the next academic session.

5. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION :-

The candidates seeking admission into the above course are required to apply in the prescribed application available in the college office on payment of Rs. 600/- through bank pay in slip, in (Ac no- 80152010004247) syndicate bank, DDCE building Branch.

The candidate may also download the application from the college website universitylawcollegebbsr.org submit the form complete in all respect along with D.D. amounting Rs. 600/- in favour of the Principal, University Law College, payable at Bhubaneswar. towards cost of the form and fees for entrance test.

6. DOCUMENT TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH ADMISSION FORM :-

- Certificate /Mark sheet of Matriculation (attested copies).
- Certificate & Mark sheet of +2 arts/Sc./Commerce or equivalent exam.(attested copies).
- Certificate & Mark sheet of +3 arts/Sc./Commerce or equivalent exam.(attested copies).
- Certificate & Mark sheet of LL.B.Examination (attested copies).
- CLC and Conduct certificate from the Head of last institution (attested copies).
- SC/ST/ Ph. /Ex-serviceman category certificate from competent issuing authority in case of candidate entitled to such benefit (attested copies).
- Two self-addressed envelope with postage fixed for communication through SPEED POST.

7. **REJECTION OF APPLICATION FORM:-**

An application form incomplete in any respect or an application received after the prescribed date and time will be summarily rejected. Postal delay is not considered as ground for delay in submission of form.

8. **SELECTION & PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION:-**

A merit list will be drawn on the basis of career-cum-entrance marks.

(a) **Career Marks: - 30 Marks**

Details of career marking out of 30 marks shall be on the basis of -the career points for each course shall be calculated out of the Total mark obtained/full Marks.

(b) **Mark secured in Entrance Test:- 70**

There will be multiple choice objective questions from the subjects like General English, Constitutional Law of India, Jurisprudence, Human Rights and Reasoning. The candidate will have to answer within 1.5 hour

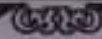
(c) There is negative marks of (0.25) for each wrong answer .

(d) For career back of 1 year there will be a deduction $\frac{1}{2}$ marks from the Total career point.

10. **DESPATCH OF INDEX, INTIMATION FOR ENTRANCE TEST AND ADMISSION:**

- The applicant has to collect the Index card from the college office or can be ascertained from the college website after the last date of submission of application form.
- Admit card can be downloaded from the college website www.universitylawcollegebbsr.org. in case of difficulty in downloading of admit card the candidates may obtain a copy of the admit card from the college office two days before the date of entrance.
- Intimation Letters for the selected candidates for admission will be sent in due course by SPEED POST only and the notification to that effect will also be made available in the college Notice Board and College website for the information of the candidates. The candidates are advised to visit the website to ascertain their respective rank in the merit list and date of admission.



1. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION:-

- (a) Suppression of the facts or giving incorrect information by the applicant if detected shall render the selection invalid. All selected candidates shall be provisionally admitted subject to verification and cross-checking of marks submitted by them by the college authorities.
- (b) The decision of the Principal regarding matters pertaining to admission shall be binding and final.
- (c) Candidates from other University shall have to produce Migration Certificate in original for University registration at the time of admission.
- (d) Candidates pursuing any other course shall not be permitted to take admission.
- (e) No hostel facility for boys & girls.

2. FEES TO BE PAID :- Total amount to be paid at the time of admission

- (a) Course fee for two years= Rs.20, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only.
- (b) Fees for seminar/ Execution classes etc. Rs. 4,000/- (Rupees Four Thousand) only for two years.

All the above fees are to be deposited at the time of admission in the shape of Demand Draft drawn in favor of the PRINCIPAL, UNIVERSITY LAW COLLEGE, payable at Bhubaneswar.

3. CAMPUS DISCIPLINE:-

- (a) A student of the college must maintain discipline within and outside the college premises. He/she must also abide by such hygienic principles and submit himself/ herself to such anti-epidemic procedure as would be laid down by college authorities.
- (b) Principal's decision, with regard to anything not covered in this prospectus or with regard to any dispute arising out of interpretation of any clause shall be final. The principal reserves the right to cancel the admission of any student and hand him over to the law and order maintaining authorities, if needed to do so, in the event such student becomes indisciplined or indulges in unlawful activities in the College or commits student unrest in the College.
